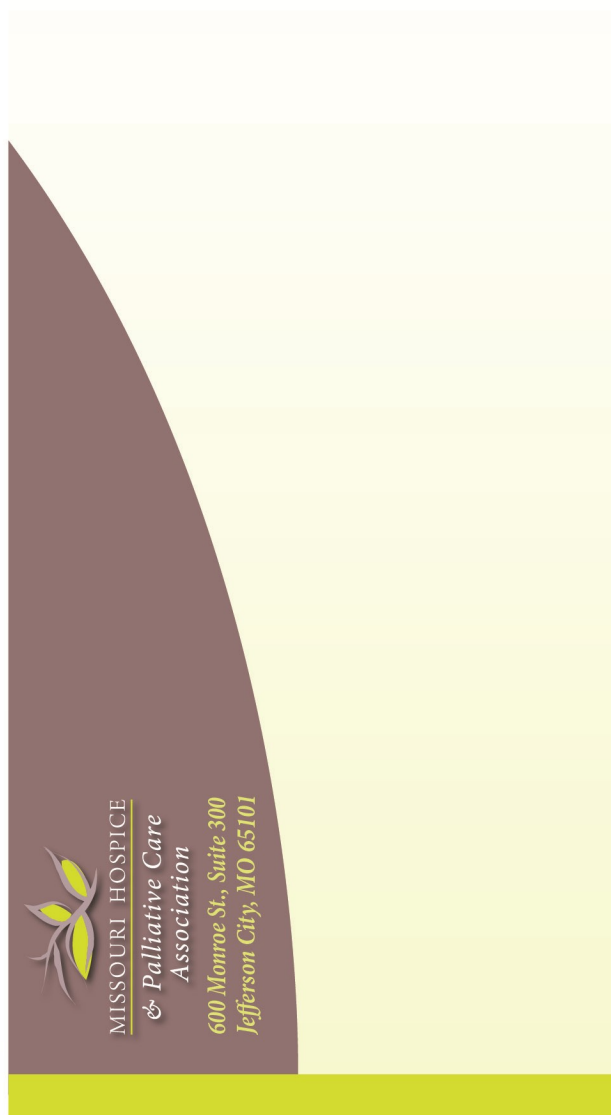

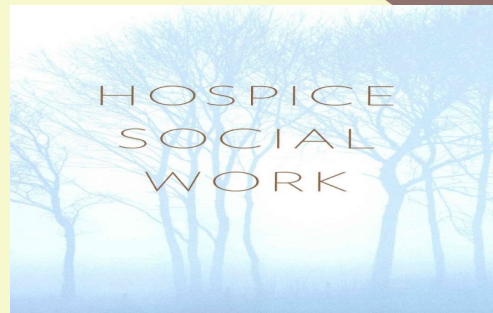

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## Outcomes:

The overall objective for attendees is education in hospice regulations, levels of care, as well as nursing home requirements and regulations. Attendees will learn how to develop a thorough hospice psychosocial assessment, identify short term therapeutic interventions and how to develop a social work plan of care in the hospice setting. Instructors will explain the team concept in the hospice setting and the role of the social worker, as well as describe a normal grief process. Speakers will explore documentation and identify areas of stress and develop a plan of care for our own wellbeing. This is a basic course for the beginning social worker with less than two years experience.

**\*This training includes a take home reference manual for each attendee to use as a resource.\***

The cost for this seminar is \$175.00 for members & \$200.00 for non-members. A \$25 late fee will apply after March 22nd, 2019. There are no refunds, however substitutions are welcome. This seminar provides 7.5 Social Worker CE hours. Upon completion of this course each attendee will be required to complete an evaluation. Each participant will then receive a certificate.
