



## Missouri Hospice & Palliative Care Association Heart of Hospice - Visionary Award

**What is the Award?** The MHPCA Heart Visionary Award is designed to honor an individual whose vision and work has advanced the quality of hospice/end of life care in Missouri, the community, state, or at a national level. (This award may not be presented each year)

**Who qualifies for this award?** The award seeks to honor an individual (not affiliated with a hospice program) who through their vision and leadership has provided collaboration that has improved hospice/end of life care through influence and impact on public policy; advancing consumer education; or improving services to their community/state, or at national level.

**Application process:** Nominations may be submitted by anyone wishing to offer a candidate for consideration.

**The application form on reverse side must be completed and enclosed.**

- Biographical narrative: Please describe the nominee's activities that make them eligible for this award in the space provided.
- Letter(s) of support: Please provide at least one letter of support from a member of the MHPCA Board of Directors supporting the nomination or your application will not be considered. Submit no more than three letters of support.
